Even as the ban on wheat export continues, due to the decision to allow shipments on prior commitment, its export has jumped 29.29 per cent to \$1.50 billion during April-November this fiscal

from \$ 1.17 billion in the year-ago period, the commerce ministry said on Friday. The government also allowed shipments on diplomatic request to meet food security of friendly countries.

Basmati rice exports have surged by 39.26 per cent to \$2.87 billion, while that of non-basmati rice registered a modest growth of 5 per cent to \$4.2 billion.

Fresh fruits exports touched \$991 million (\$954 million), while that of pulses increased by 90.49 per cent

to \$392 million, the Ministry said. Exports of processed fruits and vegetables have jumped to \$1.31 billion (\$988 million) and dairy products grew by 33.77 per cent to \$421 million.

The export of poultry products increased by 88.45 per cent to \$82 million and that of other cereals including maize by 12.9 per cent to \$699 million.

APEDA had a share of over 50 per cent in the entire export in agriculture and allied sector valued at \$ 50.21 billion during 2021-22.
