



Wheat output said to be set for a new record in 2022-23

India's wheat production may set a new record of more than 112 million tonnes in the 2022-23 crop year (July-June), official sources said. Wheat production had declined to 106.84 million tonnes following a heat wave in key growing States in 2021-22 crop year, as per the Agriculture Ministry data. In 2020-21, India had achieved a record wheat output of 109.59 million tonnes. "The crop prospect is better due to weather conditions and a slightly higher acreage," they said. PTI
